ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE WINCHESTER CITY COUNCIL (PROHIBITION OF VEHICLES) (THE BROADWAY & COLEBROOK STREET, WINCHESTER) ORDER 2022

Winchester City Council acting on behalf of Hampshire County Council in exercise of its powers and duties under Sections 1, 2, 4, 122 (1) and (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and all other enabling and amending legislation and powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

CITATION

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 24th August 2022 and may be cited as The Winchester City Council (Prohibition of Vehicles) (The Broadway & Colebrook Street, Winchester) Order 2022.
- 2. The Winchester City Council (Prohibition of Vehicles) (The Broadway & Colebrook Street, Winchester) Experimental Order 2021 shall be revoked upon the coming into operation of this Order.

INTERPRETATION

- 3. For the purposes of this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:
 - a. "prescribed hours" means the periods specified in column 2 of Schedule 1 to this Order in relation to the streets or sections of streets specified in column 1 of that Schedule;
 - b. "traffic sign" has the same meaning as in section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984; and
 - c. "vehicle" includes any part of a vehicle.

PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

- 4. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or travel along the streets or sections of streets shown in Schedule 1 to this Order during the prescribed hours, to enable Sunday Markets to be held on the Broadway.
- 5. Nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall apply to:
 - a. Market traders when used for loading and unloading;

- b. Larger vehicles requiring access for deliveries which are escorted through the closed area;
- c. Vehicles requiring access to the Bus Station;
- d. a vehicle being used for the laying, erection, alteration or repairs of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunication system provided that in all the circumstances it is reasonably necessary in the performance of such duties for that vehicle to enter any section of street specified in those articles;
- e. any vehicle when used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties provided that in all the circumstances it is reasonably necessary in the exercise of such powers or in the performance of such duties for that vehicle to enter any section of street specified in those articles.
- Nothing in this Order shall apply:
 - a. To a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigades or police purposes;
 - b. To anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform; or
 - c. To any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs places pursuant to Sections 66 or 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984.
