

WINCHESTER CITY COUNCIL – TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER PROPOSAL

THE HAMPSHIRE (LONG PRIORS, WEST MEON) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 2022

Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council proposes to make the above road traffic regulation order. The proposed Order is required to improve visibility and road safety.

There is a development of approximately 10 dwellings constructed on the western turning head in Long Priors, West Meon. It is proposed to introduce 25 metres of a no waiting restriction (double yellow lines) on the north western side of Long Priors, from a point 10 metres south of the northern turning head to a point 35 metres south of that point.

The proposed restriction will improve visibility at this junction which will have increased traffic movements when the development is occupied.
