

Please note that the North Whiteley Consortium has submitted a scoping report to Winchester City Council and received a scoping opinion, which has informed the work that has been undertaken to inform the planning application.

This representation should be read alongside the specific comments on the HRA that accompanies the Core Strategy, which have been submitted on behalf of the North Whiteley Consortium and provided under the representation to Policy CP 16 Biodiversity.

However, the North Whiteley Consortium seek a number of changes to the wording of the policy to ensure that it is **deliverable**.

1st Bullet

The intention for the woodlands to be used to, *"improve biodiversity"* needs to be clarified. It is not clear how this would be measured and whether it would be necessary to compare against the baseline situation. This phrase is open to wide interpretation and should be removed.

The reference, "*and possibly be managed as a source of renewable energy (woodfuel)*" with regard the woodlands needs to be removed. Forest Enterprise has confirmed that this is not commercially viable as they are unable to provide the level of fuel that a development of this size would need.

2nd Bullet

Whilst health facilities could be provided at North Whiteley, GPs at the Whiteley Surgery have confirmed that there is capacity at the existing surgery to provide health services to the future residents at North Whiteley. Therefore it is not anticipated that new health facilities will be required within the North Whiteley development. The Policy should be reworded to reflect this.
