

Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 Adoption of Supplementary Planning Document (Regulation 14) Littleton Village Design Statement (VDS) Adoption Statement

A Village Design Statement (VDS) has been produced for the village of Littleton (within Littleton and Harestock Parish) which identifies design criteria against which planning applications in the area will be assessed.

Winchester City Council adopted the Littleton VDS as a Supplementary Planning Document to the Winchester District Local Plan on 4th September 2023 following a public consultation period in January/February 2023. Modifications made following these consultations can be found in the report to the Cabinet Member for Place and Local Plan Decision Day meeting on 4th September 2023 (DD66). This report represents the Council's statement of public consultation, which outlines how the public was involved in the consultation on this document, the issues raised and how they have been dealt with.
