

TACT Chairs report 2023

The past two years of my chairmanship have been both challenging and rewarding. I took the position as Chair at a fully virtual meeting in 2021 and have overseen the challenges of managing hybrid meetings. The last two years have also seen a lot of changes with housing and the law that is in place.

In my report last year, I mentioned that TACT would be held at different venues. However, this has been harder than we thought and appropriate alternative venues have been difficult to find.

The May AGM was postponed and is now planned to take place in September instead. This is to allow the council time to receive the results of the Housing Quality Network (HQN) report.
