HOW TO CALCULATE MONTHLY PAYMENTS

WEEKLY RENT X 52 WEEKS /12 MONTHS = MONTHLY RENT.

E.G. £100 X 52 WEEKS/12 MONTHS = £433.34

PAYMENT ON TIME

If you pay weekly you should pay by the Friday of that week so that your payment has time to reach your account. If you pay monthly, your payment should cover a month's rent and be paid on the same date each month i.e. if you make your rent payment on the 18th of the month that the rent paid covers the rent through to the 17th of the following month.
