Alleged breach:	Without planning permission, the breach of condition 1 of the planning permission granted on appeal on 11 March 2014 under Council reference 13/01686/FUL (appeal reference APP/L1765/A/13/2207540) for the continued use of land to station a mobile home for a horticultural worker for a further three years ("the Planning Permission").  Condition 1 states:  "The mobile home hereby permitted shall be removed and the land restored to its former condition on or before the expiry of three years from the date of this decision in accordance with a scheme of works submitted to and approved by the Local Planning authority".
	This condition has not been complied with in that the mobile home remains stationed on the land and is occupied for residential purposes and the land has not been restored to its former condition.
