- 5 Unspent CIL is currently £12,480.675
- 6a HCC is responsible as the Highway Authority and the Education Authority for spending on transport, roads, and schools. However, a percentage of the unspent City Council CIL has been ring-fenced to support HCC projects, which amounts to £2,817,369.

- 6d A percentage of the unspent CIL funding has been ring-fenced for health and community projects which includes NHS projects and recreation, open spaces and playgrounds. The amount unspent which has been ring-fenced for this purpose is £3.333,416
