Waiting list length:

· The average length of the waiting list for a council property – Based on lettings between 1 April 2023 and 31 March 2024, the average waiting time for a Winchester City Council property was: 1 year 5 months

#### Band 2

1 bed – 11 months; 2 bed flat – 8 months; 2 bed house – 1 year 1 month; 3 bed – 1 year; 4+ bed - 2 years 6 months; age 55+ properties – 1 year

#### Band 3

1 bed – 3 years; 2 bed flat – 1 year 2 months; 2 bed house - 2 years 11 months; 3 bed - 2 years 4 months; 4+ bed - 5 years; age 55+ properties – 1 year 3 months
