Request:

I write to you under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 to request information from your council regarding the average EPC (Energy Performance Certificate) rating across the city of Winchester.

The specific information we are requesting is:

- The average EPC score of all dwellings throughout the city.
- The average EPC score of all dwellings throughout the city, by property type.
- The percentage of dwellings with an EPC band of 3 or below.

By all dwellings, we mean all properties, council-owned, private rent or otherwise.

Response

1. The average EPC score of all dwellings throughout the city.

Council Housing Stock

The attached Spreadsheet (Appendix Housing EPC) depicts the EPC rating of the Council's housing stock. It provides percentage of properties that fall within each EPC banding. Our average EPC Rating is C/SAP 71.

Dwellings throughout the City

In total there are currently 59,220 EPCs lodged on the Register for domestic and non-domestic dwellings within the Winchester district. This includes 55,768 domestic dwellings and 3,452 non-domestic dwellings. The EPC ratings are listed below:

Domestic dwellings:

Domestic dwellings are rated using an energy efficiency rating banded A to G, with A being the most energy efficient. Whilst the average EPC score of all domestic dwellings in Winchester district is not reported in this dataset, it is estimated to be around a C or D based on the data provided:

EPC Rating A – 446

EPC Rating B - 10,547

EPC Rating C - 17,489

EPC Rating D - 17,681

EPC Rating E - 6,828

EPC Rating F - 2,200

EPC Rating G - 577

Non-domestic dwellings:

Non-domestic dwellings are rated using an energy performance asset rating from A+ to G. Whilst the average EPC score of all non-domestic dwellings in Winchester district is not reported in this dataset, it is estimated to be around a C or D based on the data provided.


2. The average EPC score of all dwellings throughout the city, by property type.

Information on the number of Energy Performance Certificates lodged on the Register for domestic and non-domestic dwellings in England, by Local Authority and Energy Efficiency Rating (EER) can be accessed here. Please see below a breakdown of the number of dwellings with EPC scores based on property type:

Bungalow - 5095 lodgements

Flat – 12,266 lodgements

House – 37,361 lodgements



Maisonette – 850 lodgements

Non-domestic – 3,452 lodgements

Park home – 196 lodgements

Data on the average EPC score of all dwellings by property type is not provided by the Ministry of Housing, Communities & Local Government within their available datasets.

3. The percentage of dwellings with an EPC band of C or below.

In total there are currently 59,220 EPCs lodged on the Register for domestic and non-domestic dwellings within the Winchester district. This includes 55,768 domestic dwellings and 3,452 non-domestic dwellings. In total there are 47,492 dwellings (domestic and non-domestic) within the Winchester district with an EPC band of C or below. This equates to 80.2% of the dwellings lodged on the Register.
