  - b. on-street parking
  - c. council car parks
  
- 3.) Do you currently use a diesel surcharge for diesel vehicles for
  - a. parking permits,
  - b. on-street parking
  - c. council car parks?
  - d. If so, how much?
  
- 4) Could you give a breakdown for how much in total the council has made through parking charges and permits across the last five financial years eg) 19/20, 20/21, 21/22, 22/23 and 23/24

If it is not possible to provide the information requested due to the information exceeding the cost of compliance limits identified in Section 12, please provide advice and assistance, under the Section 16 obligations of the Act, as to how I can refine my request.

If you can identify any ways that my request could be refined, I would be grateful for any further advice and assistance.
