The Open Space Land is to be dedicated by Winchester City Council as highway maintainable at the public expense. Hampshire County Council is the highway authority for the area and the Open Space Land is intended to be used to upgrade a shared use path (foot and cycleway) to LTN1/20 standards. No consideration is to be paid by Hampshire County Council for the dedication.
