Request

1. How many public electric car charging points currently exist in your council area which you either own and/or manage? Please break this down by the type of charger they are.
2. How many new public electric car charging points are you planning on installing in your council area in the next 2 years that you will own and/or manage? Please break this down by the type of charger they will be.
3. How many requests for more public electric car charging points have you received from residents in your council area since 1.1.24?

Note: By 'public' charging point I mean any point that can be used by any motorist as long as they have the requisite membership card, app etc.

Response

1. There are 38 public electric car chargers in the Winchester City Council area which are either owned or managed by the council. Of these 38 chargers 12 are rapid (>50kW) chargers, 26 are fast (7kW – 50kW). The majority of these chargers are dual socketed enabling two cars to charge at the same time.
2. We do not have a set number of chargers that we plan to install over the next two years. That said we do intend to continue expanding our EV charging capacity to ensure we continue to meet growing EV charging demand. At present there are 6 new EV chargers we are looking to deploy. Five of these are fast chargers and one is a rapid charger.
3. We are not aware of any particular resident requests for additional public EV charging. Requests of this nature may be directed at Hampshire County Council instead.
