VISION: WINCHESTER COMMUNITY SAFETY PARTNERSHIP

The incidence of crime and disorder is reduced and those who live and work in, or visit Winchester feel safe, supported and listened to.

MISSION:

Winchester Community Safety Partnership remains committed to reducing crime and disorder across the district. By collaborating with both statutory and non-statutory organisations we will support those who are vulnerable in our communities and reduce the incidence of crime and disorder.

GOVERNANCE:

Winchester Community Safety Partnership Strategic Group oversees the performance management, implementation and wider delivery of strategic priorities and statutory duty.

PARTNERSHIP:

Operational delivery is undertaken in collaboration with responsible authorities in conjunction with the third sector and the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner. The responsible authorities are:

- Winchester City Council
- Hampshire & Isle of Wight Constabulary
- Hampshire & Isle of Wight Fire & Rescue Service
- Integrated Care Board
- HM Prison and Probation Service

PARTNERSHIP PRIORITIES 2025/2026

1. HIGH HARM CRIME:

We will:

- Tackle Serious Violence in all its forms to reduce the significant impact it can have on those affected.
- Put in place targeted intervention and early diversion for young males, in order to mitigate their risks in relation to serious violence offences, as victims and/or perpetrators.
- Undertake targeted operations that aim to reduce the incidence of drug and alcohol related offending.
- Put in place intervention and support for those most at risk of committing serious offences and/or becoming victims of crime.
- Raise awareness of Domestic Abuse and Violence referral pathways in order to increase support for those experiencing self-harm ideation, psychological and emotional abuse.
- Address the emerging trend linked to tech facilitated abuse.

2. ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR/PUBLIC PLACE:

We will:

- Explore the data disparity between the rural/urban split in respect of access to services and ASB reporting.
- Focus on business crime and the related incidence of ASB.
- Concentrate the partnership's efforts on tackling Violence Against Women and Girls (VAWG) in all its forms.
- Target those who perpetrate against Women and Girls in public place around the night-time economy.
- Implement targeted operations that increase feelings of safety, raise awareness of partnership priorities, reduce ASB and improve public confidence.
