If approved you will receive a street trading consent licence and will be able to trade on the Winchester Street Market subject to our usual terms and conditions.

Once your application and supporting documentation has been received, checked and verified your application will be considered within 30 days.

Additional notes and information

Food allergen matrix display

All food and drink vendors on Winchester City Council land are required to display to the public their allergen matrix of the foods that they have for sale.

Sale of alcohol

Traders as a rule will not be permitted to sell alcohol. However there be a select and specific number of times when this might be wanted, for example Christmas, or national holidays. In this circumstance a Temporary Event Notice will be required.

A Temporary Event Notice (TEN) is given by an individual (a premises user) and authorises the premises user to conduct one or more licensable activities at a premises for no more than 168 hours (7 days).

Single Use plastics

All food and drink vendors on Winchester City Council land are required to comply with the government ban and restrictions on single use plastics. This includes:

Banned:

- drinks stirrers
- cutlerv
- food and drink containers made of expanded and extruded polystyrene

Restricted

Over-the-counter sales and supply of the following single-use plastic items have restrictions:

- plates, bowls and trays
- straws

Waste

The trading pitch must be kept clean and tidy state and free from rubbish and litter at all times. At least one suitably sized waste container should be provided for use by customers and it is the responsibility of the trader to dispose of refuse arising from the business. Council, highway or other waste bins must not be used. Liquid waste must not be poured down drains or onto the pavement, road or grassland. If applicable proof of commercial waste contract will be needed.

Any waste generated by the operation of the businesses must be separated for recycling in accordance with the requirements. Traders will need to plan for their waste to be collected, or if they intend to dispose of the waste themselves, be registered as a lower tier waste carrier. Trading Vehicles

If trading from a vehicle this must have valid insurance, tax and MOT certificates. Any person driving the vehicle must a full UK driving licence.

Vehicles must not be left on site and should be parked overnight at the business / traders registered address or, if not possible, parked elsewhere and in accordance with the parking restrictions.
