TRAINING AND AWARENESS RAISING

We will:

- Promote local and national training opportunities to the forum members and the wider partnership.
- Share First2HelpYou's advice about stalking in the workplace with forum members to share with their own HR teams.
- Raise awareness of stalking and available sources of support as part of the National Personal Safety Day in November 2025.
- Promote the FOUR Warning Signs of stalking in the identification of stalking behaviours using the Fixated, Obsessive, Unwanted and Repeated (FOUR acronym).
- Encourage Winchester BID to promote First2HelpYou's advice to city centre businesses via their regular newsletters.

SIGNPOSTING

We will:

- Signpost to support services for those disclosing VAWG incident i.e. stalking and harassment.
- Develop and produce referral cards that detail support agency information for the public.
- Encourage partner organisations to Promote the Active Bystander and Behavioural Change campaigns.
- Work with internal Communication Teams to promote local support services linked to national and local campaigns.

PARTNERSHIP COLLABORATION

We will:

- Hold a Stalking Awareness Day at Trinity Women's Service to promote sources of support available.
- Focus on stalking as part of the International White Ribbon Day in November 2025.
- Advocate the use of 'Think TED'¹ to professionals managing client disclosure via Trinity Teds.
