Request

I am conducting research into collaborative insurance procurement models for municipalities in the Netherlands and would like to learn from examples in the UK — in particular, the Hampshire Insurance Forum (HIF).

I understand from several council papers (for example, from New Forest and Winchester) that an Options Appraisal was prepared by JLT Public Sector Risk Practice around 2013, which helped shape the HIF's approach to joint insurance procurement.

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, I would be very grateful if you could share a copy of that Options Appraisal, or any available summary, executive findings, or key conclusions from it. If the full document cannot be released, I would appreciate any information you can provide about its content, authorship, and commissioning process.
