Request

- How many homeless approaches from April 2022 - March 2025 Of these approaches how many assessments were taken and of the assessments how many were placed in interim accommodation (S188/189).
- How many of these clients went on to the full main duty (s193) Were these clients placed in your own stock or with a private provider What were the sizes of accommodation required and did they need any disability requirements.
- What was the average nightly rate paid for Studios/1 Beds 2 Bed 3 Bed 4 Beds plus

Response

- From April 2023- March 2025 Winchester saw 1221 approaches. Due to a change in our recording system, on 1st April 2023, I am unable to confirm this is the accurate full data from 2022-2023. This may be available on the published homelessness statistics page on Gov.uk
- 1,119 assessments were undertaken during 2022-2025 (as above for 2022- 23 data)
- 151 were owed the s188 interim accommodation.
- 115 went on to be owed the main housing duty.
- WCC have our own stock of Temporary accommodation, so do not use private providers.
- Various household sizes from 1 bed to 4 bed need. Some households would have a disability need, and we would source suitable properties from our stock.
- WCC do not use nightly rate Temporary accommodation, we have our own stock, which is a weekly rent.
