WINCHESTER CITY COUNCIL PROHIBITION OF BALL GAMES

BYELAW made by Winchester City Council under section 235 of the Local Government Act 1972 for the good rule and government of the City of Winchester and for the prevention and suppression of nuisances.

- This byelaw applies to the following area:
 - The car park area at the Colden Common Community Centre, St. Vigor Way, Colden Common, Hampshire
- No person shall play or take part in any ball game in the area described in byelaw 1.
- Any person offending against this byelaw shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding LEVEL TWO on the standard scale.
