


(PARKING PLACES AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING)
(CONTROLLED ZONE) ORDER 2002 (VARIATION NO.32) ORDER 2007

Winchester City Council acting on behalf of Hampshire County Council in exercise of its powers under sections under Sections 1,2 4,32,35,45,46,49,51 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (" the Act"), as amended by the Road Traffic Regulation (Parking) Act 1986, Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act , and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following order :-

1. In this order the "Principal Order " means "The Hampshire (Various Roads, Winchester) (Parking Places and Restriction of Waiting) (Controlled Zone) Order 2002 as amended.
2. The Principal Order shall have effect in that there shall be inserted therein a further Part to Schedule I to be referred to as Schedule I Part XX the items therein being tabulated in Schedule I to this Order.
3. The Principal Order shall have effect in that there shall be inserted therein a further Part to Schedule I to be referred to as Schedule I Part XXI the items therein being tabulated in Schedule II to this Order.
4. This Order may be cited as the Hampshire (Various Roads, Winchester) (Parking Places and Restriction of Waiting) (Controlled Zone) Order 2002 (Variation No.32) Order 2007 and shall come into operation on the day of 2007.
