TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – CHURCH ROAD AND NEW ROAD SWANMORE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Winchester City Council on behalf of Hampshire County Council has made an Order to allow for the installation of traffic calming as follows:-

ROADS TO BE CLOSED - CHURCH ROAD (From a point 200 metres north-east of the junction of New Road to a point 100 metres south-west of the junction of New Road) and NEW ROAD (From the junction of Church Road to the junction of Chapel Road)

ALTERNATIVE ROUTES: **From the western point of the closure** north-west via Church Road then south west via Lower Chase Road then south via B2177 Winchester Road then east via Forest Road then north via Gravel Hill then west via Dodds Lane **to the eastern point of the closure.**

From the eastern point of the closure east via Dodds Lane then south via Gravel Hill then west via Forest Road then north via B2177 Winchester Road then north east via Lower Chase Road the south east via Church Road **to the western point of the closure**.

From the southern point of the closure south via New Road then via Forest Road and the diversions above **to the eastern and western point of the closure**

PERIOD OF CLOSURE: From and including Monday 24th July 2006 for a period of three months or until completion of the works whichever is sooner. (Notwithstanding the above it is expected that the closure will be required for no longer than 6 weeks)

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
