NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council has made an Order to allow for carriageway surfacing works to be carried out as follows:-

ROAD TO BE CLOSED – BOARHUNT ROAD, NORTH BOARHUNT between its junction with Southwick Road (B2177) and its junction with Common Lane/Shoot Hill.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTES:

From the northern point of the closure north via Shoot Hill/Church Road, southwest via Hundred Acres Road, and then south-east via Southwick Road (B2177) to the southern point of the closure.

From the southern point of the closure north-west via Southwick Road (B2177), north-east via Hundred Acres Road, and then south-east via Church Road/Shoot Hill to the northern point of the closure.

PERIOD OF CLOSURE: From and including the 23rd April 2007 for a period of three months or until completion of the works whichever is sooner. (Notwithstanding the above it is expected that the closure will be required for no longer than 5 days)

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
