NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council had made an Order to allow for carriageway patching to be carried out as follows:-

ROAD TO BE CLOSED – HOE STREET, HAMBLEDON between its junction with Hambledon Lane/East Hoe Road/Cams Hill and its junction with Bunns Lane/Bent Lane/Martins Corner.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTES:

From the northern point of the closure west via Hambledon Lane, south via Plough Lane, south-west via Maybush Lane, south-east via Kiln Hill/Church Road and then east via Martins Corner to the southern point of the closure.

From the southern point of the closure west via Martins Corner, north-west via Church Road/Kiln Hill, then north-east via Maybush Lane, north via Plough Lane and then east via Hambledon Lane to the northern point of the closure.

PERIOD OF CLOSURE: From and including the 16th April 2007 for a period of three months or until completion of the works whichever is sooner. (Notwithstanding the above it is expected that the closure will be required for no longer than 4 days)

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
