TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – JEWRY STREET, WINCHESTER

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council proposes to make an Order to allow for drainage connection works to be carried out as follows:-

ROADS TO BE CLOSED – JEWRY STREET between its junction with St George's Street and its junction with City Road.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTES:

From the southern point of the closure south via Jewry Street, west via High Street, north-west via Upper High Street, east via Gladstone Street, north via Sussex Street, east via City Road **to the northern point of the closure.**

ORDERS TO BE SUSPENDED: None.

PERIOD OF CLOSURE: From and including the 12th August 2007 for a period of three months or until completion of the works whichever is sooner. (Notwithstanding the above it is expected that the closure will be required for no longer than 2 consecutive Sundays)

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
