PROPOSED DISPOSAL OF OPEN SPACE

Land at King George Playing Field, Bar End, Winchester

The City Council is considering the disposal of an area of open space at King George Playing Field, Bar End, Winchester, to the University of Winchester. The disposal will be by way of a lease for 125 years to the University.

The disposal is to enable the University, in partnership with the City Council, to construct a new Athletics Track and all weather pitch on this land and land which is owned by the University. Public use of the new facilities will be secured by appropriate agreements between the Council and the University.

The land is shown on plans which are available for inspection during normal office hours at the Customer Service Centre, City Offices, Colebrook Street, Winchester.

No binding decision has yet been made on these proposals and any objections should be made in writing to the Head of Legal Services, Winchester City Council, City Offices, Colebrook Street, Winchester (reference HNB/RE2/1), by close of business on 14 June 2007.
