From the southern point of the closure south via Jacklyns Lane, west via Spring Gardens, north-west via New Farm Road, east via The Avenue/Pound Hill, south via Jacklyns Lane to the western point of the closure.

STATION APPROACH

ORDERS TO BE SUSPENDED:

None.

PERIOD OF CLOSURE:

From and including the 16th May 2007 for a period of three months or until completion of the works whichever is sooner. (Notwithstanding the above the closure is only likely to be for 2 days for Jacklyns Lane and 19 days for Station Approach).

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
