ALTERNATIVE ROUTES:

From the north-western point of the closure north-west via Stockbridge Road, east via Stoney Lane, south via Andover Road, west via Bereweeke Road, north-west via Stockbridge Road **to the south-eastern point of the closure**.

From the south-eastern point of the closure south-east via Stockbridge Road, east via Bereweeke Road, north via Andover Road, west via Stoney Lane, south-east via Stockbridge Road **to the north-western point of the closure.**

ORDERS TO BE SUSPENDED: None.

PERIOD OF CLOSURE:

From and including the 25th October 2007 for a period of five days or until completion of the works whichever is sooner. (Notwithstanding the above the closure is only likely to be for 1 day)

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
