TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – RANELAGH ROAD, WINCHESTER

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council has made an Order to allow for carriageway repair works to be carried out as follows:-

ROADS TO BE CLOSED – RANELAGH ROAD, WINCHESTER between its junction with Christchurch Road and its junction with Cromwell Road (the railway bridge)

ALTERNATIVE ROUTES:

From the western point of the closure south-west via Cromwell Road, east via Stanmore Lane, east via Lower Stanmore Lane, north via St Cross Road, west via Ranelagh Road **to the eastern point of the closure.**

From the eastern point of the closure east via Ranelagh Road, south via St Cross Road, west via Lower Stanmore Lane, west via Stanmore Lane, north-east via Cromwell Road **to the western point of the closure.**

ORDERS TO BE SUSPENDED: None.

PERIOD OF CLOSURE: From and including the 1st October 2007 for a period of three months or until completion of the works whichever is sooner. (Notwithstanding the above it is expected that the closure will be required for no longer than 1 day)

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
