From the southern point of the closure south-east via Airlie Road/Ranlegh Road, north via St Cross Road, west via St James' Lane to the northern point of the closure.

PERIOD OF CLOSURE: From and including the 7th April 2008 for a period of three months or until completion of the works whichever is sooner. (Notwithstanding the above it is expected that the closure will be required for no longer than 2 weeks)

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
