# WINCHESTER CITY COUNCIL TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES – VARIOUS ROADS, WINCHESTER DISTRICT.

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council propose to make an Order to allow for routine maintenance works to be carried out as follows:-

#### **ROADS TO BE CLOSED:**

### 1. WHEELY DOWN ROAD, WARNFORD

Planned approx. 1 day duration for pre surface dressing patching between its junction with Kilmeston Road and its junction with the A32 Warnford Road.

## 2. RIVERSDOWN ROAD, WARNFORD

Planned approx. 5 day duration for pre surface dressing patching between its junction with Wheely Down Road and its junction with Joans Acre Lane.

## 3. JOANS ACRE LANE, BRAMDEAN

Planned approx. 2 day duration for pre surface dressing patching between its junction with Hinton Hill and its junction with Brockwood Park Lane.

#### 4. BROCKWOOD PARK LANE, BRAMDEAN

Planned approx. 1 day duration for pre surface dressing patching between its junction with Riversdown Road and its junction with Brockwood.

## 5. BROCKWOOD, BRAMDEAN

Planned approx. 1 day duration for pre surface dressing patching between its junction with the A272 Petersfield Road and its junction with Riversdown Road.

#### 6. LIPPEN LANE, WEST MEON.

Planned approx. 1 day duration for pre surface dressing patching between its junction with the A32 Warnford Road and its junction with Lippen Lane at Lippen Woods.

**ALTERNATIVE ROUTES:** Alternative routes will be signposted at the time of closure. Individual road closures in the same area will be implemented consecutively and not simultaneously.

**PERIOD OF CLOSURE:** The closures are enforceable between the 8<sup>th</sup> December 2008 and the 31<sup>st</sup> March 2009 or until the completion of the works whichever is sooner. (Notwithstanding the above, it is expected that the closure of each individual road will only be required for between 1 and 20 working days)

With the exception of any emergency works, advance warning signs will be displayed approximately 2 weeks in advance of any road closure being enforced.

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out. Letters will be sent to properties affected at the appropriate time notifying them of the detailed arrangements.
