NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council proposes to make an Order to enable Portsmouth Water Limited to carry out water main improvement works as follows:-

ROADS TO BE CLOSED(IN SEQUENCE):

<u>Phase 1:</u> Bank Street, junction Free Street & Hoe Lane to a point 50metres west of its junction with Shore Lane. Start: 29th Jan. 2009 – Duration approximately 1 week

<u>Phase 2</u>: Free Street junction Bank Street to junction Corhampton Road. <u>Start: 9th Feb. 2009 – Duration approximately 7 weeks</u>

<u>Phase 3:</u>Shore Lane junction Winchester Road to junction Cricklemede. Start: 30th Mar. 2009 – Duration approximately 4 weeks

<u>Phase 4</u>: Shore Lane junction Cricklemede to junction with Bank Street. <u>Start: 27th Apr 2009 – Duration approximately 5 weeks</u>

ALTERNATIVE ROUTES:

Phase 1 & 2. From the **northern point of closure** south west via Lower Lane & Corhampton Road, south east via Winchester Road, north via Shore lane, north east via Cricklemede, west via Hoe Road to the **southern point of the closure and vice versa**. **Phase 3 & 4.** From the **northern point of the closure**(north via Shore Lane), east via Bank Street, north via Free Street, Southwest via Lower lane & Corhampton Road, south west via Winchester Road to the **southern point of the closure and vice versa**. **Access to Bishops Waltham Village** via Lower Lane to Bank Street and Basingwell Street to The Square & High Street will not be affected however access from Hoe Road via Bank Street will be closed only for the duration of **Phase 1. above**.

PERIOD OF CLOSURE: From and including the **29th January 2009** for a period of **six months** or until completion of the works whichever is sooner. (**Notwithstanding the above it is expected that the closure will be required as detailed above.**) Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
