ALTERNATIVE ROUTES:

BURNETT CLOSE – From the southern point of the closure north-west via Stockbridge Road, south-east via Godwin Close to the northern point of the closure. From the northern point of the closure north-west via Godwin Close, south-east via Stockbridge Road to the southern point of the closure.

OSPREY WALK – via Stoney Lane and Fromond Road and vice verse.

ORDERS TO BE SUSPENDED: None.

PERIOD OF CLOSURE: From and including the 29th June 2009 for three months or until completion of the works whichever is sooner. (Notwithstanding the above it is expected that the closure will be required for no longer than 5 weeks)

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
