From the northern point of the closure, north via Stoke Charity Road/Old Stoke Road, west via Wonston Lane, north via Oxford Road, north-east via Stockbridge Road, south via Overton Road, south-east via Larkwhistle Farm Road, south-west via the A33 Basingstoke Road, north-west via Lovedon Lane to the southern point of the closure.

ORDERS TO BE SUSPENDED: 7.5 ton weight limit on Stoke Charity Road.

PERIOD OF CLOSURE: From and including the 27th March 2010 for six months or until completion of the works whichever is sooner. (Notwithstanding the above it is expected that there will be an initial closure of **2 days on 27th/28th March 2010**, followed by the main closure commencing on **6th April 2010 for 3 months**)

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
