TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - VARIOUS ROADS - 10/11 NO. 2

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council proposes to make an order on traffic management grounds to allow for routine maintenance works to be undertaken as follows:

ROADS TO BE CLOSED:

- 1. Apless Lane, Southwick between its junction with Forest Road and its junction with Beckford Lane. (anticipated period of 3 days)
- 2. <u>Beckford Lane, Southwick</u> between its junction with Apless Lane and its junction with Common Lane. (anticipated period of 3 days)
- 3. <u>Common Lane, Southwick</u> between its junction with Shoot Hill and its junction with Back Lane. (anticipated period of 1 day)
- 4. <u>Common Lane, Southwick</u> between its junction with Shoot Hill and its junction with B2177 (Southwick Road). (anticipated period of 1 day)
- 5. Monument Lane, Southwick for its entire length. (anticipated period of 1 day)
- 6. Ham Road, Southwick for its entire length (anticipated period of 1 day)
- Portchester Lane, Southwick for its entire length. (anticipated period of 1 day)
- 8. <u>Crooked Walk Lane, Southwick</u> for its entire length. (anticipated period of 1 day)
- 9. <u>High Street, Southwick</u> for its entire length (anticipated period of 1 day)
- 10. <u>Ashley Down Lane, Southwick</u> for its entire length. (anticipated period of 1 day)
- 11. West Street, Southwick for its entire length. (anticipated period of 1 day)

ALTERNATIVE ROUTES:

Alternative routes will be signposted at the time of closure. Individual road closures in the same area will be implemented consecutively and not simultaneously.

PERIOD OF CLOSURE:

From 17th May 2010 for a period of 12 months or until completion of the works. With the exception of any emergency works, advance warning signs will be displayed approximately 2 weeks in advance of any road closure being enforced.

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
