From the north-western point of the closure south-west via the B3035 Botley Road, south-east via Reading Room Lane, north-east via the A334 Winchester Road **to the south-eastern point of the closure**.

ORDERS TO BE SUSPENDED: None.

PERIOD OF CLOSURE: From and including the 18th October 2010 for twelve months or until completion of the works whichever is sooner. (Notwithstanding the above it is expected that the closure will be required for no longer than 1 week)

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
