TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – JACKLYNS LANE, ALRESFORD

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council has made an Order on traffic management grounds to allow for tree works to be carried out as follows:-

ROADS TO BE CLOSED: JACKLYNS LANE, ALRESFORD between its junction with Grange Road/Nursery Road and its junction with Station Approach.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTES: **From the northern point of closure** north via Jacklyns Lane, west via West Street/The Avenue, south via Bridge Road, east via Grange Road **to the southern point of the closure**.

From the southern pint of the closure west via Grange Road, north via Bridge Road, east via The Avenue/West Street, south via Jacklyns Lane **to the northern point of the closure**.

ORDERS TO BE SUSPENDED: None.

PERIOD OF CLOSURE: From and including the 18th January 2012 for three months or until completion of the works whichever is sooner. (Notwithstanding the above it is expected that the closure will be required for no longer than 2 periods of 1 day each)

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
