## THE WINCHESTER CITY (PARISH OF SHEDFIELD) (FOOTPATH NO.3) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 1997

On 12 March 2012, Winchester City Council confirmed the above Order.

The effect of the Order will be to stop up the length of the public footpath which runs from GR 554139 for a total of approximately 40 metres from its junction with Sandy Lane in a northerly direction for a distance of 20 metres, turns northeast for 160 metres, north for 50 metres then continues in a north easterly direction for 60 metres and then turns southeast for 110 metres to GR 558139 and to create an alternative public footpath which commences at GR 554139 runs north for a distance of approximately 20 metres then northeast for 130 metres, north for 50 metres, north for 50 metres, southeast for 10 metres, east for 70 metres and then southeast for 50 metres to rejoin the existing public footpath at GR 558139 as shown on the Order map.

This Order came into force on the 12 March 2012 but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question its validity or that of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the Order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of those purposes under section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within six weeks from the date on which notice is first published as required by paragraph 7 of Schedule 14 to the Act.
