## Notes

- The Attendance at Meetings (possible) column relates to those meetings where the Councillor was a member of the body concerned. It includes meetings arranged at short notice. It does not include meetings where the Councillor attended as a Ward Member or Portfolio Holder to make representations, where they deputised for another Councillor, or meetings in the community or of outside bodies with which the Councillor is involved. Members also attend other meetings with parish councils, partnerships, Council Officers and/or other Members to discuss Council business. These meetings are also not included in the statistics above.
- 2. The majority of formal committees have deputies appointed. On most occasions when a Councillor could not attend a meeting of which he/she was a member, their absence was covered by a deputy.
