The effect of this order proposals for which were advertised on 15th June 2016 will be to extend waiting provisions in Shelley Close and Browning Drive, Winchester to improve visibility and pedestrian safety details are as follows

Any person who wishes to question the validity of any of the above orders or any of the provisions of the orders on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with may, within six weeks of the date when the orders were made apply to the High Court for that purpose.
