The Winchester City (Parish of Curdridge)
(Part of Footpath 9 Curdridge)
Public Path Diversion Order 2019

On 28<sup>th</sup> August 2019 Winchester City Council confirmed the above Order.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert a section of Footpath 9 Curdridge running from A to D and create a new section of footpath running from A to B to C to D as shown on the Order Map.

This Order came into force on 28<sup>th</sup> August 2019 but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question its validity or that of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the Order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under section 287 of the Town & Country Planning Act 1990 within 6 weeks from the date on which this notice is published as required by paragraph 7 of Schedule 14 to that Act.
