**The Winchester City (Parish of Curdridge)  
(Part of Footpath 9 Curdridge)  
Public Path Diversion Order 2019**

The above Order was made on 16<sup>th</sup> July 2019. The effect of the Order will be to divert a section of Footpath 9 Curdridge running from A to D and create a new section of footpath running from A to B to C to D as shown on the Order Map.

Copies of the Order and Map may be bought there at the price of £2.00.

Representations about or objections to the Order must be in writing and received by the Interim Service Lead – Legal & Deputy Monitoring Officer, Winchester City Council, City Offices, Colebrook Street, Winchester, SO23 9LJ no later than 19<sup>th</sup> August 2019.

Please note that because the making of the Order is a legal process involving a public right of way any representations or objections, including the name and address of the person making the representation or objection, may be made public.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, Winchester City Council has authority to confirm the Order as an unopposed order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for Homes, Communities and Local Government for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
