

NOTICE OF PROPOSED TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

THE HAMPSHIRE (VARIOUS ROADS, WINCHESTER) (PARKING PLACES AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) (CONTROLLED ZONE) (NO. 2) ORDER 2012 (VARIATION NO. 15) ORDER 2019

Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers. If the Order comes into force it will introduce the following changes:

1. The proposals are to address an inconsistency between the original order and the current road markings. The amendment ensures the order and road markings match.
