

NOTICE OF TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER MADE BY WINCHESTER CITY COUNCIL

Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and regulation 17 of the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996.

THE HAMPSHIRE (VARIOUS ROADS WINCHESTER) (PARKING PLACES AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) (CONTROLLED ZONE) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2010 (VARIATION NO.59) ORDER 2019

Winchester City Council pursuant to arrangements made with Hampshire County Council under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 gives notice that it has made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (RTRA 1984) the effect of which is as follows:

Clauses to be inserted into the Principal Order

- 24. Any proprietor of business premises situated in:-
- 24.1. permit zones F, V and Z6 may apply to the Council for the issue of a permit for the leaving of a relevant vehicle at any time in any parking place situated in the same permit zone as those business premises by any person normally employed at those premises;.
- 24.2. permit zone V and Z6 may apply to the Council for the issue of a permit for the leaving of a relevant vehicle at any time in any parking place situated in that permit zone by any customer of that business, subject to no more than 6 permits being available for use in respect of that business address.
- 26. Any person, organisation or school whose premises are situated in the inner or outer areas may apply to the Council for the issue of a permit for the leaving of a relevant vehicle by any person attending those premises for the purpose of participating in activities organised by an amenity, community group or school, at any time in any parking place specified in Schedule 1 to this Order situated in the same permit zone as those premises, subject to no more than 20 such permits being available for use in respect of any particular premises.
 - 1. The Order has been made to allow permit entitlement for businesses and schools in the new zone (Zone Z6) parking area in Winnall, Winchester.
 - 2. The Order comes into operation on **01 May 2019.**
 - 3. Access to properties adjoining the road will not be affected by the Order
 - 4. A copy of the Order as made, plans showing the parts of the highway affected and a statement of the traffic authority's reasons for making the Order may be inspected free of charge at City Offices, Winchester SO23 9LJ by appointment or during opening hours as advertised, or via the Council's website.
 - 5. Any person wishing to challenge the Order on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the RTRA 1984 or that any requirements of that, or of any instrument made under it have not been complied with may apply to the High Court within six weeks following **01 May 2019**.
