

PARKING PERMITS – CONTROLLED ZONE Z6 (WINNALL, WINCHESTER)

On 1st February 2019 Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council made an experimental traffic regulation order as follows:

EFFECT OF ORDER:

To introduce Clauses and revised Schedule to The Hampshire (Various Roads, Winchester) (Parking Places and Restriction of Waiting) (Controlled Zone) (Consolidation) Order 2010 as amended to enable Charities registered with the Charity Commission for England and Wales whose premises are in Zone Z6 of the Order to be entitled to "Charity" permits for employees.

IMPLEMENTATION:

The changes to the Order will come into effect on 6th February 2019.

The Order is to be on an experimental basis for a maximum period of 18 months and the Council will in due course consider whether the provisions of the Order should continue in force indefinitely.

OBJECTIONS:

Within a period of six months from when the experimental Order comes into force or if the Order is subsequently varied or modified within six months of the date of the coming into force of such variation or modification pursuant to Section 10 (2) of the Road Traffic Act 1984, any person may object to the making of an order for the purpose of such indefinite continuation.
