THE HAMPSHIRE (VARIOUS ROADS, BISHOPS WALTHAM) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 1985 (VARIATION NO.3) ORDER 2021

Winchester City Council pursuant to arrangements made with Hampshire County Council gives notice that it has made the above road traffic order Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 122 (1) and (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), as amended by the Road Traffic Regulation (Parking) Act 1986 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The effect of the Order is to:

- 1. Introduce lengths of no waiting at any time (double yellow lines) on Martin Street, and Victoria Road Bishop's Waltham
- 2. Introduce lengths of no waiting at any time (double yellow lines) on Coppice Hill, Bishop's Waltham, either side of the junction with Saxby Road

The Order will come into operation on 20th September 2021.
