

TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER PROPOSAL

THE WINCHESTER CITY (BARFIELD CLOSE AND ST CATHERINE'S VIEW)
(OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2003 (VARIATION NO.4) ORDER 2021

Winchester City Council with the consent of Hampshire County Council made the above road traffic regulation order on 9th September 2021. The Order comes into operation on 20th September 2021. The effect of the order is to introduce additional coach parking at South Winchester Park & Ride, Otterbourne Road, Winchester.

The introduction of additional coach parking at South Winchester Park and Ride will reduce coach movements through the centre of Winchester. Coaches, using The Broadway as a drop off, will head to South Winchester via the motorway, rather traversing Winchester to park in the existing coach park at Worthy Lane.

Additional amendments have been made to:

- 1. update the interpretations as statutory provisions and specifications detailed in the principal order are no longer in force.
- 2. include new definitions that relate to virtual tickets, electric vehicles, classes of vehicle and parking bays.
- 3. update and amend articles that need renewing and revising and to include virtual tickets and parking facilities for electric vehicles (which are already in operation in the car parks to which the principal and previous variation orders relate to.)
- 4. update The Schedule to include all the Park & Ride sites and update the class of vehicle and prescribed charging hours columns (the charges to reflect those which have been payable since 6th October 2020 following a Notice of Variation of Off-Street Parking Charges).
