

## NOTICE OF PROPOSED TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

## THE WINCHESTER CITY (BARFIELD CLOSE AND ST CATHERINE'S VIEW) (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2003 (VARIATION NO. 5) ORDER 2021

Winchester City Council with the consent of Hampshire County Council proposes making the above road traffic regulation order. The effect of this order will be to introduce a new car park situated off Barfield Close, Winchester, Hampshire, known as **Barfield Park & Ride Phase 2.** 

The charges for the car park's use together with the restrictions of times during which it may be used and by which classes of vehicle are detailed below:
