



## NOTICE OF PROPOSED TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

### THE HAMPSHIRE (VARIOUS ROADS UPPER MEON VALLEY) (PARKING PLACES AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 2019

Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers. If the Order comes into force it will introduce the following changes:

1. To introduce 'No Waiting at Any Time' restrictions (double yellow lines) on De Port Heights at the junction with the A32 Warnford Road to address road safety and traffic management problems caused by vehicles parking near the junction.

#### NEW SCHEDULE No waiting at any time

DE PORT HEIGHTS	BOTH	BETWEEN ITS JUNCTION WITH THE A32 WARNFORD ROAD AND A POINT 14.4 METRES EAST OF THAT JUNCTION.
